The 5th and 6th modules of training has taken place in May and August 2023 at Kodaikanal Hills. A total of 25 staff were in the training. It is continuously bringing wonderful change in the lives of the field staff and growth in their ministry. Our staff are learning to teach new believers to read and understand the bible. The focus is to strengthen them in the Scriptures.

UPDATE: SEMAI AND SENOI NATIVES (ORANG ASLI) PAHANG, MALAYSIA



Praise God that He gave us exciting developments to share in this update. We are delighted and praise God that he has provided the completed Lighthouse ministry house as a mission base and hub for His work in the interiors. We are truly thankful to God for His help. This mission base is a ministry centre, training/teaching center and guest house for God's servants who visit this village to minister and to serve among the many Semai and Senoi neighbouring villages in Pahang.



The other neighbouring villages of Ulu Ruai, Hilir Ruai, Ulu Renggol, Kampung Ulu Klang, Kampung Gabang and Pos Betau, all Senoi villages in central Pahang are now being served for the Gospel of Christ.



The centre is also used to uplift the children's literacy to help them learn educational independence. There is also Educational outreach to Ulu Ruai village with 20 plus children of the village. Brother Jeff has been teaching them for the last 6 months faithfully. Pray for the impact of his teaching that many children are motivated to pursue studies. The local Semai's help and assist Brother Jeff to teach and educate the children of Ulu Ruai weekly. Senoi and Semai children received books and study tools through the gifts and blessings of supporters and sponsors. Education is a primary tool to reach out to the villages, besides teaching them Bible stories and Sunday school activities.



Recently I preached the Word of God to the community of faith in the Semalin village.



Ephesians 2:10 reminds us that: "We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."
